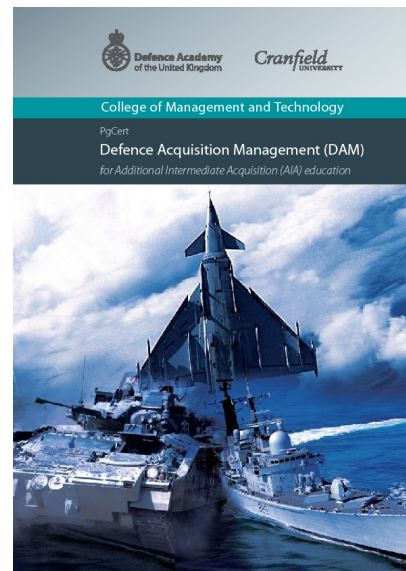


Places are still available on the Defence Acquisition Management courses at DA-CMT Shrivenham, starting part-time in January 2010. As these are MOD funded there is no charge, but applicants will need their employer's agreement to attend the residential modules and meet any T&S costs.

These are accredited courses delivered by Cranfield University and can lead to a Postgraduate Certificate, a Postgraduate Diploma or an MSc in Defence Acquisition Management.

Courses are open to both military and civilian personnel who are suitably qualified (a First- or Second-Class Honours degree in an appropriate subject together with relevant experience). The intention is to enable applicants to expand their knowledge and hence their future deployability by investing in their personal development. The courses provide in-depth knowledge of the theories, concepts and analytical techniques relevant to capability, procurement, contracting, logistics, supply chain management and equipment support. A key element is the eligibility for the relevant qualification of the Chartered Institute of Purchasing and Supply (CIPS) and the Chartered Institute of logistics (CILT). Applicants may also sit examinations for the Association of Project Management and the Chartered Management Institute (CMI).
